Note:- The policy approved by PSOC (vide DMW/32200/1/PSOC dated 12 July 2001) for retention of
defence pool accommodation on EOSC is as under: -

- (a) Officer posted to High Intensity, High Risk and Anti Insurgency areas and permitted retention of
MOD Pool accn for 6 months vide letter No 39987/12/CAO/Q1 dated 07 Mar 1995 will not be allowed
any further retention of MOD Pool Accn on any grounds. They will also shift to SFA, if allotted earlier,
subject to grant of leave.
- (b) In all other cases, retention of MOD Pool Accn due to exigency of service will be permitted for
one month by GOC and additional one month by GOC-in-C equivalents. There will be no further
extension. The certificate for the purpose duly signed by GOC or GOC-in-C equivalent is required to be
furnished to CAO/E-1 well in time.
- (c) Officers entitled for reserved accn at new duty stn shall not be entitled for retention of accn at
previous duty stn on EOS grounds unless permitted retention of accn at previous duty stn on Children
Education Grounds.
- (d) This policy will be effective from 01 Aug 2001. All cases where sanction has been given prior to
this date will be regularized as per previous orders on the subject.
